ICAHD Half-day 'Matrix of Control' tours

Whether in Jerusalem on your own or with a group of friends, you can arrange for ICAHD to take you on our "Matrix of Control" tour to witness the situation on the ground. See the Separation Wall, roads and tunnels that connect to Jewish settlements while isolating Palestinian neighborhoods and stop at sites where Palestinian homes have been demolished. Gain a wide range of information about social, cultural and historical issues that help underlie the Israeli-Palestinian conflict.

In-depth ten-day study tours

Each spring and autumn, ICAHD, in partnership with ETT, a UK-based tour company, runs an in-depth ten-day study tour. As well as witnessing the situation on the ground, participants have a unique opportunity to meet with Jews, Christians and Muslims from both sides of the divide examining several aspects of life today in Palestine, Jerusalem and Israel. Gain some of the latest analysis representing a broad set of opinions - yet focused on the forces of peace in both Palestinian and Israeli societies. For effective programs of advocacy by international civil society, the understanding that we provide is proving critical.

Full tour programme provided, stay in three-star hotel rooms with private facilities on half-board (bed, breakfast and evening meal), tour guides and tips. Not included: flights, lunches, supplement for single room. For an application form contact: tours@icahduk.org.

ICAHD's summer rebuilding camps

Held annually since 2002, ICAHD brings together internationals to join with Israelis and Palestinians as they stand side by side, refusing to be enemies, rebuilding a Palestinian home that has been demolished by Israeli bulldozers. Learn first-hand about the struggle of ordinary Palestinians and Israel's most cruel policy of house demolitions, illegal under international law.

In two weeks, build an entire house and also have the opportunity to participate in field trips. Meet people and organisations from both sides of the divide. Leave empowered to raise awareness about the conflict and encourage others back home to get involved in campaigning for the end of the occupation with a just and sustainable solution for all.

Dates for 2011 are 10 - 26 July in Anata, East Jerusalem. Cost of the camp with basic accommodation and all meals provided at Beit Arabiya, plus field trips and programme is \$1500, including a donation towards the costs of building materials.
